Lecture, group discussion, professional interaction and role play approaches are used to facilitate learning. *Attendees who meet all prerequisites and complete the workshop are eligible to apply for the new national Certificate of Tobacco Treatment Practice, and ultimately the new national Certified Tobacco Treatment Specialist (anticipated 2019).*
